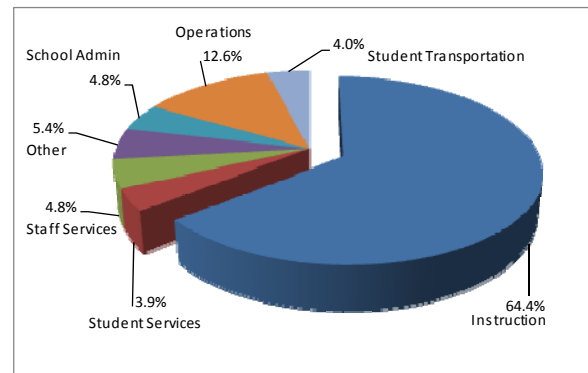

# Excellence in All We Do

## Academic Excellence

Academic excellence in Park City can be expressed and measured in many ways. Here are just a few:

- ✓ Park City High School ranks best in the state by KSL News and second by Newsweek Magazine.
- ✓ All schools meet federal No Child Left Behind standards.
- ✓ Students consistently score better on nationwide tests than state and national counterparts.
- ✓ 86% of the district's 1st through 7th graders were proficient or better in state tests of the math curriculum; 91 percent of the secondary students were proficient in the language arts.
- ✓ High school graduates often continue their education at some of the nation's top universities. Recent graduates attend Amherst, Harvard, Brown, Columbia, Princeton, Northwestern, United States Military Academy, and many others.

## Teaching Excellence

PCSD attracts and retains well qualified educators.

- ✓ According to Utah State Office of Education reports, 78 percent of the district's teachers are highly qualified; the state average is only 73 percent.
- ✓ 58 percent of the District's professional staff have advanced degrees (Master's and above) compared with 41 percent of the State as a whole.
- ✓ PCSD teachers and administrators are continually recognized for their outstanding efforts and talents. Some of the awards received include: the Utah Siemens National AP Teacher of the Year, Milken Educator of the Year, Fulbright Teacher Exchange Grant, Outstanding Health Occupations Students of American Advisor, the Utah Association for Adult, Community and Continuing Education Award of Excellence, and the State Middle School Team Award.

## All Around Excellence

The District strives for excellence in every endeavor.

- ✓ In addition to receiving numerous architectural awards, the newly renovated Park City High School was the first high school in the state to be LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Certified.
- ✓ The Utah State Office of Education ranked the school lunch menus offered by Park City School District as the best in the state.
- ✓ A District bus driver and trainer won top honors in this year's Utah School Bus Safety Road-E-O. He took first place in the Expert Division and goes on to represent Utah at the International School Bus Driver Safety Competition.
- ✓ District staff excel out of school as well. For example, a District employee was named a member of the U.S.A. Deaf Women's Golf Team. She will represent her country at the World Deaf Golf Championships. Another was recently named to her alma mater's athletic hall of fame.
- ✓ Park City High School students were named as Best Teen Chef and Volunteer of the Year.
- ✓ Parley's Park Elementary students took top honors in the Utah State Elementary Chess Championships. PPES students also placed eighth in a national language arts competition entered by approximately 220,000 students annually.
